As I place my fingers to the keys of my computer and think about events that have taken place since our last update to you from Tanzania, my mind swirls with the training events of the past three months. I pray that you will be drawn into the happenings and realities of what God is doing in this beautiful land where He has called us to serve. Come with me as I share some of these wonderful events.

The first week of January started off our training events for the year by bringing to our training center some of our church planters for a week of refresher training and lots of fun and fellowship. Those who attended said the event was wonderful and hoped that our team would try to bring them back again every year. Be praying that this time of rest and relaxation could become a reality for all of our families who are serving on the front lines.



As you know, CHE (Community Health Evangelism) is the core of our training emphases to transform communities with the

light of Christ. During the month of January we held our first ever TOT 2 (Training of Trainers), which empowers our national CHE trainers to train others to begin the process of going beyond where they are today and into new communities. We are very excited with how God is using this training to bring so many into the kingdom of Christ ... seeing the poorest of the poor transformed from darkness to light.



During the month of February we held a training entitled ME (Micro Enterprise) TOT 1. An American by the name of John Carter wrote the lesson plans for this course and trained us. We were amazed at the level of understanding our nationals gained in how to write a simple business plan that would help them with some simple principles about developing income for them and their communities, and keep money in their pockets. Pray as we develop the best process to help our CHE communities with this new learning about gaining some financial freedom.



In March we began our first Church Planter Training Course for this year. We feel so blessed at how God is using our training center to fill so many lives with knowledge about the Bible, health, literacy, Farming God's Way, CHE, and kingdom business. When our families return to their homes, they take with them a new worldview of how to live life and live it more abundantly.



Overlapping all of these training events was an additional two-month training course teaching some of our mission center staff how to help our environment and the communities where they live. We have been blessed to have Lomayani, a Tanzanian, as a part of our training staff who has a gift of reaching deep into his peoples' lives with the reality of how to take care of God's creation. Please pray that those who have been trained will help our mission-training center become a pleasing environment for all who come to live and be trained.
